## FIRST AID, CPR, & AED Training Implementation Guide 2020-2021

*“Every person seeking initial licensure or renewal of a license shall provide evidence of completion of certification or training in emergency first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and the use of automated external defibrillators. The certification or training program shall (i) be based on the current national evidence-based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines for cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator... and (ii) include hands-on practice of the skills necessary to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation.” ~Virginia HB 1829 (effective 9.1.17)*

**FOR CERTIFIED STAFF ONLY with VDOE license expiration date of June 30, 2021.**

*“Any individual seeking an initial license or renewal of licensure and who has completed all other components of training in emergency first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and the use of automated external defibrillator shall be relieved of the requirement to have hands-on practice of the skills necessary to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation for the purpose of their licensure application until June 30, 2021.”*

**TEACHERS:** Once you have completed online training for all three components of FA, CPR, and AED, you may print your certificate to turn in with your renewal packet. Be sure to select a program with all three components.

You may use any online service for your FA, CPR, and AED certification.

Suggestions: Nationalcprfoundation.com, the American Red Cross, the American Heart Association, or ProTrainings through the division.

For certified staff whose VDOE license expires on June 30, 2021, MCPS has set up an online option with ProTrainings.

Certified staff wishing to utilize this service will need to closely adhere to the following instructions:

- Individuals may register for ProTrainings First Aid/CPR/AED online training through a school nurse. Please write a check for **\$25** (checks payable to Auburn High School) and give this to your school nurse. He/she will register you for the online course.
- ProTrainings will email you a login/password and instructions to begin online training.
- Online training will take approximately 4 hours and may be completed in one or more sessions.
- After online training is completed, you will be able to print out a certificate of completion to be used for your VDOE license renewal.
